Patient Quick Notes - Mainly designed to give a running tally of how the patient is doing in-between appointments, clinicians are encouraged to record all encounters.

These notes record who contacted the patient last and are date and time stamped.

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Patient Treatment Notes- Mainly designed to record information against a particular visit (if a patient has a high INR and the reason was discussed or patient turned up late for the appointment).

Recording Patient Treatment Notes:

1. Enter message in **"Treatment Notes"** box.
